

# A-LEVEL FINE ART

This course offers students the opportunity to discover how to communicate ideas and meanings in an expressive, inventive and very personal manner whilst at the same time exploring the real career pathways offered by this discipline.

The fine artists who deliver the course will help students to really 'see' the world around them and record their observations in new and exciting ways.

Students will experiment with abstract, figurative and symbolic approaches to visual communication using a whole range of approaches including drawing, painting and printmaking.

**Duration:** Two years

**Entry requirements:** Five GCSEs at A\*-B and maths and English minimum C grade.

**Course content:** A wide range of exciting assignments covering relative topics using both practical and theoretical approaches.

**Final grades will give the following UCAS point scores of:** C-80, B-100, A-120, A\*-140.

On successful completion of the course students will have the skills and qualifications needed to progress onto a wide range of courses at foundation or degree level, or to go directly into industry.
