A-LEVEL **PHOTOGRAPHY**

The course will enable students to learn a wide range of photographic skills and technical abilities. This can then be applied to a range of short assignments, where inspiration from the work of other photographers and students imagination can be explored.

Students will have the opportunity to utilise our fully equipped darkrooms, to produce their own black and white stimulating experimental imagery. There is the opportunity to use a wide range of camera equipment, both digital and film.

Fully qualified and talented staff will help students produce a range of exciting assignments covering practical and theoretical topics.

Year two builds on growing expertise and imagination. The final unit culminates in a chosen topic studied at great depth and producing high quality photographic images.

Duration: Two years

Entry requirements: Five GCSEs at A*-B and maths and English minimum C grade.

Course content: A diverse range of exciting and stimulating assignments covering practical and theoretical as well as commercial topics.

Final grades will give the following UCAS point scores of: C-80, B-100, A-120, A*-140.

On successful completion of the course students will have the skills and qualifications needed to progress onto a wide range of courses at foundation or degree level, or to go directly into industry.

The qualification you will be awarded is titled A-Level Art and Design: Photography - lens and light-based media.
